
Why is disability-inclusive safeguarding important for all non-governmental organisations (NGOs) and civil society organisations (CSOs)?

Remember:



Don't feel put off by the terminology! Disability inclusion in safeguarding is not complicated.



Advocate upwardly and outwardly for disability-inclusive child safeguarding.



Be transparent about including costs for disability-inclusive child safeguarding in donor proposals. They need to know that it takes resources and "cheapest is not best."
